The required supplies are ones that every child will need to function in the classroom; the optional supplies are ones that are not required but will make our classes run more efficiently and effectively. Please note that certain brands or sizes of items are specified due to WCPSS or other requirements. Thank you in advance for supporting your child and our school!

Two packs of Wide Ruled notebook paper9. One white 100% cotton tee-shirt (3 sizes larger than wearing now). Label with child's name. Will be tie-dyed and worn during field trips. <p>Please do not label supplies with names, except the tee-shirt. 4th Grade Required Supplies

1. One white 100% cotton tee-shirt several sizes too large with your child's name inside the collar.
2. Twenty-four or more #2 pencils (or mechanical pencils)
3. Two packs of lined, 3-hole punched notebook paper (college ruled)
4. Eight composition notebooks
5. Highlighters (any color)
6. Eight folders with tabs in the middle

5th Grade Required Supplies

1. A box of pencils

4. One durable pencil pouch (not pencil box) for keeping pencils and other supplies
5. Eight composition books (no spirals)
6. Eight two-pocket folders with brads
7. One pack of colored pencils
8. One red pen
9. One blue pen
10. One black pen
11. Three rolls of scotch tape
12. One pack of Post-it notes
13. A book to read
14. One white 100% cotton tee-shirt to tie-dye for field trips (2 sizes larger than wearing now) with your name inside the collar.
15. A healthy bag lunch or \$2.00 for a cafeteria lunch (breakfast costs \$1.00)
16. A healthy snack
17. Individual pencil sharpeners will **not** be needed, so leave these at home

5th Grade Optional Supplies

1. Wet Ones baby wipes
2. Clorox (Lemon Fresh or Fresh Scent) wipes
3. Paper towels
